

## Trinchero Napa Reserve Highlights

### Merlot “Chicken Ranch”

- Location:** The 28-acre Chicken Ranch is in the Rutherford district of Napa Valley.
- Fact:** Located at Napa Valley's widest point, the Rutherford appellation spends more time in the sun than its neighbors creating a higher radiant value.
- The Wine:** Trinchero’s Chicken Ranch Merlot is soft, generous, lightly herbal, forward and fruity. It is a wine that drinks beautifully in its youth.

### Cabernet “Chicken Ranch”

- Location:** The 28-acre Chicken Ranch is in the Rutherford district of Napa Valley.
- Fact:** Located at Napa Valley's widest point, the Rutherford appellation spends more time in the sun than its neighbors creating a higher radiant value.
- The Wine:** Trinchero’s Chicken Ranch Cabernet is deep, forward, lush and fruity. Its opulence and soft tannins make it ideal for early consumption.

### Cabernet “Main Street”

- Location:** The 22-acre Main Street Vineyard is located at the southern end of St. Helena, considered by many to be the perfect ripening zone for Cabernet.
- Fact:** Main Street is a level site with nutrient-poor soils, good sun exposure and excellent air circulation.
- The Wine:** Trinchero’s Main Street Cabernet delivers ripe, earthy flavors and extraordinary complexity. It is dense, balanced and built to age gracefully.

### Cabernet “Lewelling”

- Location:** The 22-acre Lewelling Vineyard is located west of Highway 29 at the base of the Mayacamas Mountains in St. Helena.
- Fact:** This gently sloping, benchland site is considered one of the finest vineyards in Napa Valley.
- The Wine:** Trinchero’s Lewelling is textbook benchland Cab. It is packed with earth, cedar and cassis and has the power and structure to improve with age.

### Meritage

### **Chardonnay “Vista Montone”**

- Location:** The rolling, 120-acre Vista Monte Vineyard is set to the east of Carneros in the American Canyon region overlooking San Francisco Bay.
- Fact:** Although not entitled to the Carneros designation, it shares many geological and climatic traits with its famous, cool-climate neighbor.
- The Wine:** Trinchero’s Vista Montone Chardonnay defines the expression understated power. It is dense, well-structured and delicious.

### **Pinot Noir “Vista Montone”**

- Location:** The rolling, 120-acre Vista Monte Vineyard is set to the east of Carneros in the American Canyon region overlooking San Francisco Bay.
- Fact:** Although not entitled to the Carneros designation, it shares many geological and climatic traits with its famous, cool-climate neighbor.
- The Wine:** Trinchero’s Vista Montone Pinot Noir is deep, firm and spicy. It has bright fruit, exotic overtones and fine tannins.

### **Sauvignon Blanc “Mary’s Vineyard”**

- Location:** Located north of St. Helena and south of Calistoga, the 22-acre Mary’s Vineyard was the first property purchased by the Trinchero family.
- Fact:** For greater complexity, this level, well-exposed site is planted to two clones of Sauvignon Blanc: Wente and Musque.
- The Wine:** Trinchero’s Mary’s Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc melds the ripe melon and fig flavors normally associated with warmer sites with the firm acids and steely structure found in cooler locales.

### **Meritage**

- Location:** Trinchero’s Meritage blends mountain-grown fruit for power and backbone with Valley and Bench fruit for richness and opulence.
- Fact:** In most years this wine features four of the five red Bordeaux varieties - Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot.
- The Wine:** Trinchero’s Meritage is deep, dense and imposing with exquisite balance and incredible complexity.
